NATIONAL AGENCY FOR PETROLEUM, NATURAL GAS AND BIOFUELS

RESOLUTION No. 789, of 22 May 2019

Amends the ANP Resolution No. 52, of 29 December 2019, which establishes the marine fuel oils specifications, by reducing the maximum limit of sulphur content in marine fuels for the vessels without exhaust gas cleaning system.

THE BOARD OF THE NATIONAL AGENCY FOR PETROLEUM, NATURAL GAS AND BIOFUELS (*Agência Nacional do Petróleo, Gás Natural e Biocombustíveis* – "<u>ANP</u>"), exercising its duties, pursuant to the provisions of article 6th, of the Internal Regulation and the article 7th, of the Annex I of Decree No. 2,455, of 14 January 1998, considering the dispositions of the Law No. 9,478, of 6 August 1997, considering the Proceedings No. 48610.011094/2018-28, and according to the deliberations taken in the 977^a Board Meeting, held on 22 May 2019, determines:

Article 1. The Technical Regulation No. 5/2010, annex to the ANP Resolution No. 52, of 29 December 2010, shall be read now with the following wording:

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(g) Vessels with an exhaust gas cleaning system ("scrubber") will be allowed to be supplied with marine fuel oils with a maximum limit of sulphur content of 3.50% in mass".
